I am pleased to announce that Eric Vermillion has been named to the position of Vice Chancellor, Finance, as approved by the Regents at their May 18 meeting. Eric has served as Associate Vice Chancellor of Finance since 2003.

Eric will continue to report directly to me and will continue to serve as the principal finance and resource lead over an array of UCSF's management and stewardship activities, specifically including UCSF budget and planning, financial management and compliance programs and Mission Bay Campus development.

This appointment is in recognition of the significant increase in institutional and fiduciary responsibility Eric has assumed over the last three years, including oversight of the UCSF Controller's Office, which has reported to Eric on a temporary basis since June 1, 2008. In addition to the Controller's Office, Eric oversees Campus Budget and Resource Management, Purchasing and Business Services, Contracting, and Campus Risk Management Services.

Eric started his career at UCSF in 1979 in the Campus Planning Office as a principal analyst and has since held positions of progressive responsibility. He has served in the Campus Budget Office as the managing analyst responsible for coordinating the Chancellor's Five-Year Plan and developing short- and long-range strategies for the campus' capital financing and reserve funding plan; the Campus Facilities Management Department as the Chief Financial Officer and Controller, and the Assistant Vice Chancellor-Budget and Resource Management, where he managed the resource review and allocation process for the campus, federal costing administration and rate negotiations, and resource planning and management decision support analysis for the business and external financing plans for the Mission Bay Campus.

Nationally, Eric is a member of the Board of the Council on Governmental Relations, an association of research universities; a member of the Society for College and University Planners and a member of the National Association of Colleges and University Planners. He is also past national chair of the Group on Institutional Planning for the Association of American Medical Colleges.

Eric has tremendous institutional knowledge and a deep devotion to UCSF. Please join me in congratulating Eric.
