In 2011, she joined UCSF as Associate Vice Chancellor for Budget & Resource Management. In the last year, she ably led the overall FAS enterprise as Interim Senior Vice Chancellor, Finance and Administration. Prior to her success at UCSF, she worked across the bay at UC Berkeley within administration and at the Haas School of Business – where I had the great pleasure to work directly with her during my tenure at Berkeley.

In addition to her strong UC credentials, Teresa is actively engaged in working on national-level solutions to challenges facing higher education. She is on the presidential track at the Western Association of College and University Business Officers, and is a forthcoming board member of NACUBO – the related national organization. She frequently presents on higher education topics at various national conferences and is faculty at the Business Management Institute. Closer to home, Teresa is active in several Bay Area community organizations and is an avid sports fan.
