

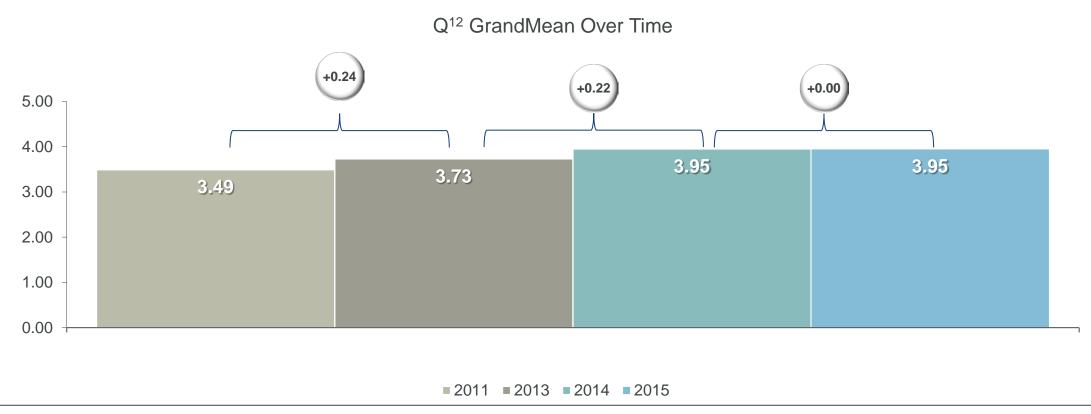

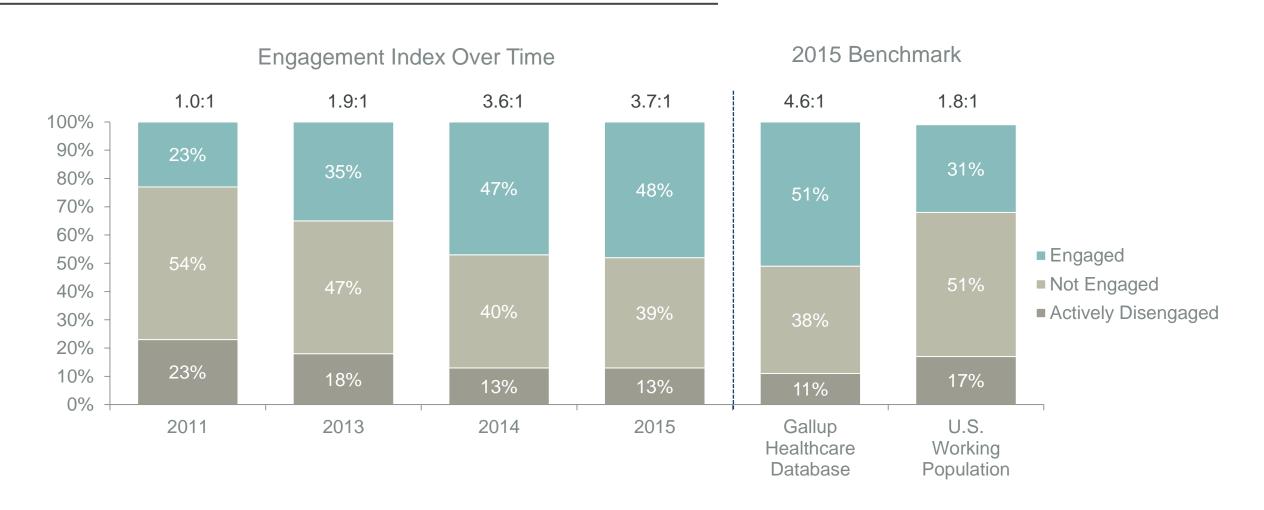

## FAS GrandMean Trended 2011 - 2015

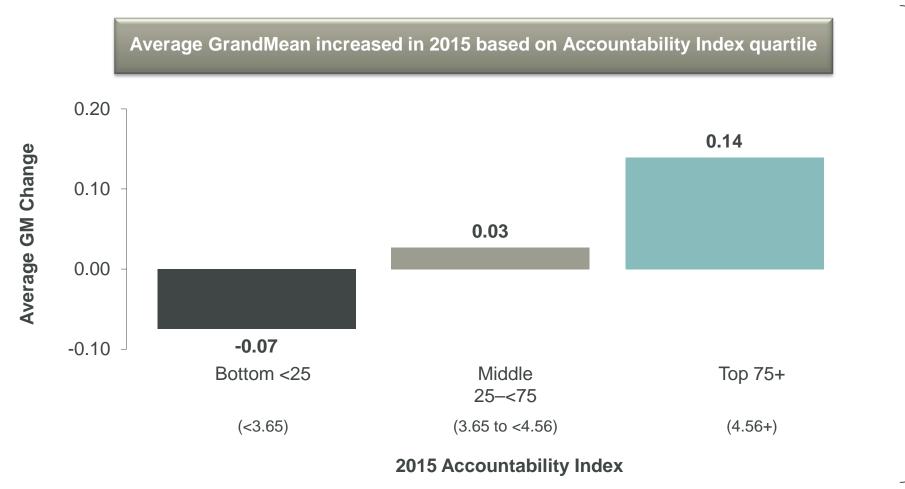


- FAS outperformed benchmarks in accumulative improvement in GM increases over the 4 cycles (+.46 for FAS vs +.34 for top quartile of Gallup database)
- However, FAS plateaued in 2015 which confirms Gallup's guidance that increases are harder to come by in year 4 and beyond
- FAS GM remains at 41<sup>st</sup> percentile of Gallup database

## 48% of FAS employees are engaged, while actively disengaged remained constant. FAS is moving closer to the 4:1 Engagement Tipping Point



# Campus Data Supports Gallup Advice that Progress Around Action Planning is the Single Most Influential Driver of GrandMean Improvement Year Over Year



Those in the top quartile in accountability in 2015 showed an average GM increase of 0.14.
